Fermentation and aging: Whole berry destemming, 4 - 5 day cold soak, punch downs 3 times per day. Native yeast fermentation in small, open top-one, ton fermenters. 15% co-fermentation of Petite Verdot. Total skin contact 24 days. Barrel aged 21 months in 95% new French oak. Bottled unfiltered and unfiltered.

Tasting notes: Warm blackberry, cherry and violets are elegantly present in the aromas. As the wine opens up, a bit of crushed stone, forest floor and ripe raspberry come through. Elegant and rich deep flavors of black cherry and pepper spice lead to a smooth, luxurious finish.

Aging potential: 6 to 10 years
