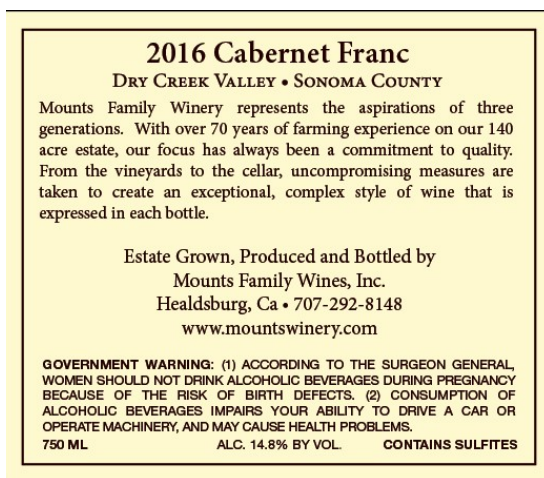

Tasting notes: fragrant aromas of violets, black cherry, and pepper spice. Mouthwatering taste of rich black fruit, spice box, and sweet jalapeño. Medium to full bodied, and smooth, luxurious tannins.

Aging potential: 6 to 10 years
